PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, carcinoid cancer, and related neuroendocrine tumors (NETs), can be fatal if not treated properly and within enough time; and

WHEREAS, carcinoid cancer tumors and NETs are often slow to develop and often unnoticed by most patients and health professionals using current medical technology; and

WHEREAS, over 90 per cent of all carcinoid/NETs are incorrectly diagnosed and treated for the wrong disease; and

WHEREAS, there are more than 11,000 new diagnoses of carcinoid cancer and NETs in the United States each year; and

WHEREAS, the Carcinoid Cancer Foundation will hold its fourth annual event, the Zebra Ball - Stars for Stripes, to raise awareness about carcinoid cancer and NETs, on February 13, 2010:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICHARD M, DALEY, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO, do hereby proclaim February 2010, to be CARCINOID CANCER/NETS AWARENESS MONTH and urge all Chicagoans to be aware of the dangers of carcinoid cancer and NETs, and to support medical research to improve the detection of these diseases.
